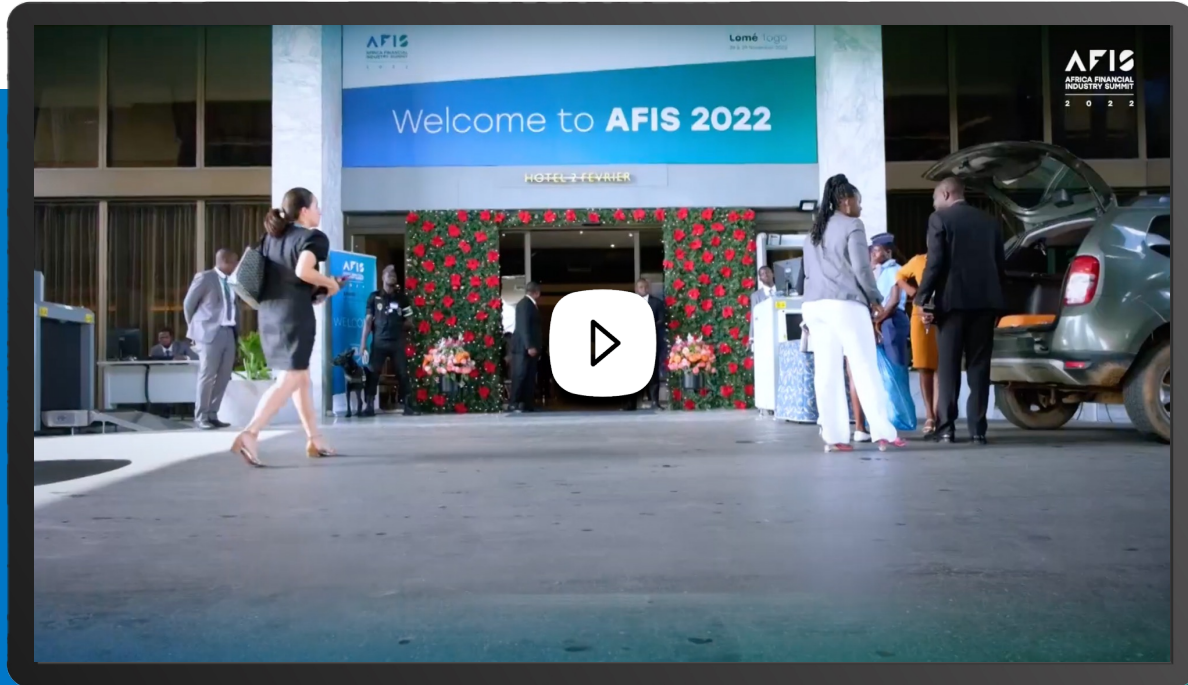

Decisionmakers at the centre of discussions

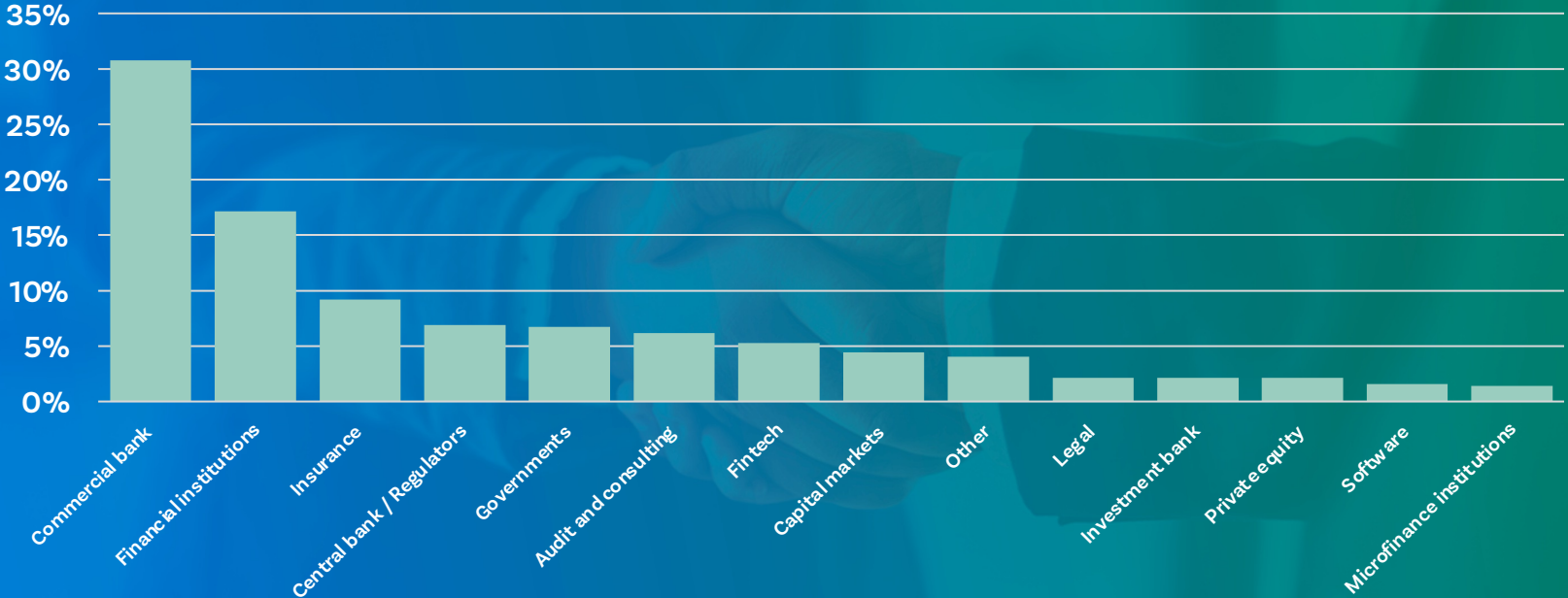

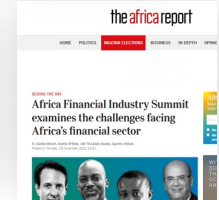
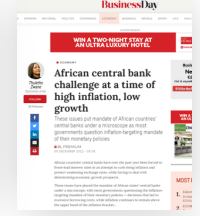
