

We can't blame European Banks

"When we see foreign banks leaving, we replace them; we create greater financial inclusion, we deepen the markets ... to the point where our governments don't need to look elsewhere for finance – we can provide long-term funding for infrastructure." Speaking in front of hundreds of delegates, including Togolese President Faure Gnassingbé, the Nigerian Tycoon – and founder of Access Bank – Herbert Wigwe underlined that Access Bank wants to drive the next wave of continental integration. "We can't blame European or American banks who choose not to be here. We blame ourselves if we are not big enough to support our people," he said, adding that Lagos could be a "financial hub for the whole region".

15 workshops to solve financial industry challenges

During 15 Roundtables, financial industry executives, fintechs and regulators discussed recommendations on how to build a world-class African financial industry. Among the many topics addressed: FX risk management; Basel III in Africa; Green taxonomy; Cyber threats; Payments: The race for scale; Global economic reform; Rethinking PPPs; Securing tech talent. More than 500 participants joined at least one Roundtable during the two-day Summit, including CEOs, Central Bank Governors and regulators.

Towards a Single African Currency?

As the African Continental Free Trade Area (AfCFTA) takes shape, three Central Bank Governors have grappled with the monetary question. **Jean-Claude Kassi Brou**, Governor of the BCEAO, emphasized, "This will be the culmination: a single currency with a single central bank." **Aivo Andrianarivelo**, the Malagasy governor, added, "We need to do things in the right order. The priority is to eliminate barriers to trade between our countries. We are still far from an African Schengen." **Manuel António Tiago Dias**, Governor of the Central Bank of Angola, explained, "As long as trade between African countries remains low, we will remain dependent on the dollar."

Hundreds of deals and meetings

Leveraging a customised matchmaking app and exclusive meeting spaces, AFIS is becoming the place of interactions between regulators, fintech pioneers. insurers, capital market players, mobile money operators, and commercial and development banks. During the event, 3000 messages were sent though our networking app. More than 500 business meetings took place. AFIS also took a leading role in deal brokering: Ecobank and the African Guarantee Fund (AGF) joined forces in a groundbreaking \$200 million risk-sharing agreement, aimed at catalyzing economic growth and supporting entrepreneurial ventures - including women-owned SMEs on the continent. This landmark partnership covers 27 countries, providing a 50% coverage for eligible SMEs across all target markets.


